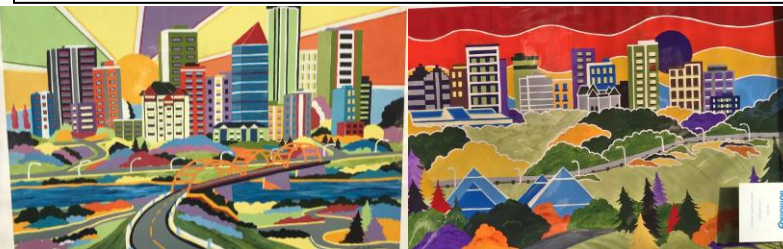

We have entered into a partnership agreement for discounted registration rates and use of space and equipment at the YMCA for pickleball and floor curling. These programs are running well and picking up momentum while we figure out how to make them work for everyone.
